Item: Approval of Minutes- February 8, 2022

Info: Emily Eisenman explained that the County Budget for FY2024 for an additional Environmental Health Employee was not approved by the County at this time. Mark Thomas explained that the district can start the process for a feasibility study to be completed.

Item: New Business

Info: Ms. Deborah Epps is requesting a waiver or variance for property 1091 Hodges Mill Road. Ms. Epps Explained to the board that a mobile home had previously been on the property with an individual sewage disposal system. The mobile home had recently been demolished and plans were being made to build a new home on the property. Kellie Hinson explained to the board that a replacement system cannot be installed due to rocky unusable soil and the required stream buffer. (attached letter Mcarthur & Mcarthur).

Item: Environmental Health Update Keli Hinson

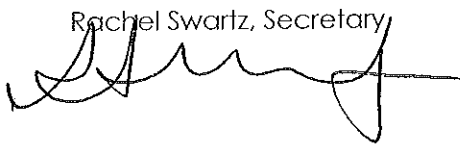
Info: Keli Hinson presented to the Board a presentation on Environmental Health program overview. (see attachment)
