Recreation Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes – May 21, 2024

Minutes:

1. Call to Order – The Recreation Committee convened the regular meeting at Herman C. Michael Park. Leslie Hunsinger called the meeting to order.
2. Approve the agenda. Richard Ashmore made a motion to approve the agenda. Dan Moore seconded the motion to approve the agenda. Motion approved unanimously.
3. Approve March 19 Meeting Minutes. Richard Ashmore made a motion to approve the minutes and Jason Hewell seconded the motion. Motion approved unanimously.
4. Park and program updates. Davol provided information regarding spring program season, summer registration, fall tackle football/cheer registration and staffing. Davol stated that the Oconee Parks Foundation was scheduled to meet June 6 with no July meeting. In addition, Davol said that the custodial services RFP recommendation was submitted, Dawson Park RFP for construction engineer contractors was underway and Heritage Park improvements construction documents were in process by SPG. Davol added that construction documents for the OVP Tennis expansion project was in progress.

Sebring stated that BSC quad scoreboard replacement had started, installation for lightning protection at HCM and HP was scheduled and Laserturf had planned field work for June to include verticutting at OVP soccer and laser grading fields at BSC quad. Davol ended with an update on the HCM light pole replacement and fence repair from vehicle incident.

5. HCM Disc Golf Course. Sebring and Hartzog provided a history of the Disc Golf course which was built in 2008. Sebring informed the group of improvements for the course to include adding 9 concrete tee pads, basket refurbish kits with arrow directional indicators for next hole, and updated signage to be ordered once other improvements are completed. Avolio said that there has been good social media feedback on the new tee pads. Avolio also discussed recommendations on a few holes/baskets, such as adding posts to enable basket locations to be moved.



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6. Other Business.

- Avolio inquired about the adult soccer program that had 4 teams registered this spring.
- Dan Moore asked about Youth Tackle Football equipment policy which has been positive.
