Hanley called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

Approval of Agenda: Shook made a move to approve the agenda, second by Davis. The vote was unanimous to approve the agenda.

No corrections were made to the minutes from the May 22, 2026, meeting. Upon motion by Davis and second by Shook, minutes from the May 22, 2026, meeting were unanimously approved.

New Business

- a) Pre-Certification of June 16, 2026, General Primary Runoff Election. Each board member reviewed each precinct's totals on the Statement of Votes Cast and verified totals matched on the precertification meeting review form. Chair Hanley read the totals aloud. Upon motion by Shook and second by Jones, precertification was unanimously approved.
- b) Hanley referenced the Election Summary Report while board members reviewed. Certification of June 16, 2026, General Primary Runoff Election – Motion was made by Shook and seconded by Jones to certify the results of the June 16, 2026, General Primary Runoff Election. All were in favor.



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Director's Report

- a) Advance Voting update by Gregg indicated no issues during advance voting for the June 16, 2026, General Primary Runoff Election.
- b) Gregg indicated no issues on Election Day and that the accessible area placed at the Oconee County Civic Center operated smoothly and was a great success.

- a) June 24, 2026 – 9:00 a.m. Recount Republican Public Service Commission District 3
- b) June 29, 2026 – 9:00 a.m. Risk Limiting Audit
- c) Discussion was had regarding the July 6, 2026, regular Board Meeting. A call for a special election TSPLOST to be placed on the November 3, 2026, ballot must be made within 90 days which requires a meeting to call the election to occur on July 29, 2026. Upon motion by Shook and second by Davis, the July and August regular meetings are requested to be combined on July 29, 2026, at 5 p.m. All were in favor.
- d) August 3, 2026 - Board Meeting - Call for Special Election TSPLOST
- e) August 17, 2026 – First Day to Accept Absentee Applications for the November General Election

Additional Action

- a) Davis mentioned the Senate Bill currently being reviewed during the Special Session of the General Assembly and recommended the board draft a statement in opposition of the amendment to the bill regarding manual recounts. Upon motion by Jones and second by Davis, the board authorizes Chair Hanley to draft and send a statement on behalf of the Board in opposition to the amendment. All were in favor.
